**ENF Board OK's Additional \$1.4 Million** The incredible fiscal year just ended, which saw the endowment fund rebound from a down year with 25.6 percent growth, recordbreaking support from the membership, and the biggest year for bequests since 1991-92.

Meeting for the first time this fiscal year on May 8 in Chicago, the Board voted unanimously to spend an additional \$900,000 on the Community Investments Program to expand the philanthropic reach of Elks Lodges. In addition, the Board increased the Bonus Grant pool to the state associations by \$500,000.
