PGER Michael Luhr issued a challenge at the 2019 Elks National Convention to raise \$783,000.00 to help preserve, restore and modernize the USS Arizona Memorial. To this end the Elks are partnering with the Pacific Historical Parks, a WWII focused 501(C)(3) tax-exempt public benefit organization that oversees the Pearl Harbor National Memorial.

Funds raised will be used to replace faded and peeling outdoor exhibits, build digital and interactive displays, modernize the museums with iPads and touch screens and install new programs and software.
