The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks held their Annual Northeast Central Regional Hoop Shoot Competition on March 22, 2014 in Wilkes-Barre, PA.

Kamdyn McClain who represented Olean Lodge #491, Joseph Girard III represented Glens Falls Lodge #81 and Grace Thomas represented Owego Lodge #1039 were the winners in the Boys 8-9 year old competition, Boys 12-13 year old competition and the Girls 12-13 year old competition, Kamdyn, Joseph and Grace have qualified for the National Finals in Springfield, MA on April 12, 2014. They competed against the State Champions from New Jersey and Pennsylvania, Kamdyn, Joseph and Grace became State Champion in Syracuse, NY after qualifying in Local, District and State Regional Competition.

Kamdyn, Joseph and Grace will now compete against 11 other contestants, in each age group, throughout the United States on April 12th to become the National Hoop Shoot Champion. Winners of the National Competition will receive first place honors and will also have their name inscribed on the wall of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, MA.
