2017 Grand Lodge Resolutions

These resolutions will be voted at GL.

1.Amend 2.010 to delete local lodge choice of short form of initiation.

2.Amend 15.070 to allow a lodge to meet but once a month

3.Amend 3.080 to allow officer nominations at the January meeting for lodges meeting monthly.

4.Amend 3.090 to allow officer election at the February meeting for lodges meeting monthly.

5.Amend 16.020 to require all lodges to incorporate.

6.Amend 16.090 to allow, by adopted bylaw, club rooms to remain open during meetings. No bar service permitted.

S1.Amend 2.010 to only allow long form of initiation-PA State Association

S2.Add 4.490 to require long form of initiation at DD Visit-PA, MA State Assn
