Honorable Kenneth V. Cantoli, PGER, of Wall Township, NJ passed away on Thursday, July 9, 2009. He was born in Hoboken and resided in Hasbrouck Heights for over 40 years until moving to the Jersey Shore in 1985. He was a founding member of that town's Elks Lodge, BPO Elks 1962, subsequently becoming its Exalted Ruler. His involvement in the Elks expanded to the state level, where he was appointed State President and ultimately to the national organization where his work with the Grand Lodge culminated in his appointment in 1983 as Grand Exalted Ruler.
